<Korean Traditional Knot: Dragonfly magnet>

The kit includes:

Completed dragonfly knot (sample)
Threads for dragonfly knots
Threads for tail decoration
Magnet

Also, you will need:

Wood glue

Super glue

Scissors

Sharp tool such as awl, needle, toothpick

How to make a dragonfly:

1. Making the first set of wings

- 1) Place a starting knot at the bottom and the ends of the string on your left and right.
- 2) Take the right string and bring it over the left and around, and make a knot (this will be the body of a dragonfly).
- 3.) Let's call the left thread 1 and the right thread 2.
- ** When you tighten the knot, make sure the size of the knot is not bigger than your pinky nail.
- 4) Make a small loop, which becomes a left wing of the dragonfly, using thread 1.
- 5) Make another loop, which becomes a right wing of the dragonfly, using thread 2 on the other side of it.
- 6) Make thread 2 on your left into the left loop (wing) by inserting the thread from bottom to top. .
- 7) Take thread 1 on your right into the right loop that was made in step 2 from bottom to top.
- 8) Tighten the loops by pulling the tails and wings while holding the body of the dragonfly.

2. Adjusting the size of wings:

- 1) Make wings smaller by pulling the tails until the desired size is reached.
- 2) Make wings bigger by pulling the upper side of the wings until the desired size is reached.
- 3) Make sure that the body is a square shape.



3. Making the second set of wings

- : Get the tails ready to make the second set of wings. Repeat the previous steps to make them.
- 1) Take the right string and bring it over the left and around, and make a knot
- 2) Let's call the left thread 1 and the right thread 2
- 3) Make a small loop, which becomes a left wing of the dragonfly, using thread 1.
- 4) Make another loop, which becomes a right wing of the dragonfly, using thread 2 on the other side of it.
- 5) Take thread 2 on your left into a left loop that was made in step 2 from bottom to top.
- 6) Take thread 1 on your right into a right loop that was made in step 2 from bottom to top.
- 7) Tighten the loops by pulling the tails and wings.
- 8) Adjust the size of the wings by pulling the tails or the upper side of the wings.

4. Final steps to complete

- 1) Once the wings are completed, cut the tails to the desired length.
- 2) Using a sharp tool like a needle or a toothpick, add some wood glue to the middle and ends of the tails to keep the threads from coming untied.

5. Adding thread wraps to tail

- 1) Use thread to decorate the tail by making a loop in the shape of backwards number "9."
- ** Thicker thread is used in the Youtube tutorial for a clearer explanation.
- 2) Place the loop on the tail.
- 3) Start to wrap over the loop from the bottom of the tail (about 1 centimeter).
- 4) Lastly, pull the end of the thread through a loop that is made at the end.
- 5) Tighten the knot by pulling the end of the tail and the thread both ways.
- 6) Cut off the excess thread using scissors. Add some wood glue to the ends of the thread to keep the wraps from coming untied.
- 7) Add super glue to the magnet and attach it to the body of the dragonfly.
