The kit includes:

Gwang-mok (cotton cloth)

Paper pattern for tracing

4 mini Yut-sticks

8 Yut-tokens

Also you will need:

Scotch tape

Fabric markers (you can purchase them on our website: THE LINK ADDRESS)

Instructions:

- 1. Place the gwang-mok (cotton cloth) on your work table so that the string is positioned in the top left corner
- 2. Center the paper pattern for tracing on the cotton cloth and secure it with scotch tape.
- 3. Use a fabric marker to trace the circles.
- 4. Remove the pattern from the cloth.
- 5. Draw lines between the circles using a ruler
- 6. Decorate the circles as you would like

7. Once decoration is completed, place the mini Yut-sticks and Yut-tokens on the cloth in the corner opposite the string.

8. Fold the bottom right corner up to the center of the fabric first,

Then fold the bottom left corner and top right corner up to the center of the fabric,

Then fold up to the top left and tie with the attached string.
